

Department of Medical Imaging – Post Biopsy / Aspiration Instructions

- 1. Please get plenty of rest for 24 hours after the procedure.
- 2. There are no diet restrictions. You may eat what you wish.
- 3. Avoid, for 24 hours:
 - Strenuous exercise
 - Lifting heavy objects
 - Medication containing A.S.A/Aspirin
 - Driving or operating heavy machinery if you have received sedation
- You may restart your blood thinners after 24 hours unless otherwise instructed by your physician.
- 5. Patients should have a ride and from the hospital, or take a taxi. We do not recommend that you take public transit.
- 6. Lung biopsy patients should avoid air travel from two weeks post biopsy, unless otherwise advised by the radiologist or surgeon.
- 7. Consult your doctor, or go to the nearest Emergency Department, if you experience any of the following:
 - Severe pain
 - Sever bruising or swelling at the site of your test
 - Fever
 - Shortness of breath
 - Coughing up blood
 - Bright red blood in your urine
 - Faintness or light-headedness
- 8. Can have a shower after 24 hours and remove dressing.
