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Overview of Rotation

A core clerkship rotation in the Department of Anesthesia at North York General Hospital involves eight days of clinical exposure and two full-day simulator sessions. Students will learn IV skills, airway management, acute pain management and resuscitation skills.

Schedule

The schedule is provided by the Undergraduate Department for OR assignments and simulator schedule. There is no call in the clerkship rotation for Anesthesia. Full attendance for the two-week block is expected unless cleared by the clerkship office.

Preceptor Assignment

Students are booked in operating rooms that are appropriate for the level of training and that will give the best exposure to technical skills and learning objectives for the rotation.

Educational Activities

Rounds are every Wednesday morning at 7:30 a.m. except during summer months. Seminars are set as “learning modules” are expected to be completed online before the end of the rotation.

Assessment

Trainees have daily assessments completed by staff based on CanMeds competencies. Their preceptor for the day completes the evaluation and they are compiled to complete the final evaluation. Clinical work is 40% and the final exam is 60% of the evaluation.
