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Overview of Rotation

We offer rotations to all senior residents in both paediatric anesthesia and as well as a community anesthesia elective. Pediatric residents can expect to spend >80% of their clinical time in a pediatric OR. Senior residents on a community rotation will have graded responsibility in all varieties of cases North York General Hospital offers.

Schedule

The schedule is determined either in consultation with the Postgraduate Supervisor at The Hospital for Sick Children based on the resident's clinical requirements at that hospital or for community rotations in communication with the North York General Education Lead. As rotations are very short, vacation is usually not expected during the rotation. Senior community residents can take call, as they see fit, to benefit their educational goals.

Preceptor Assignment

Residents will be booked in rooms appropriate for the type of experience they are here for (paediatrics vs. community elective) and preceptors assigned based on OR assignments.

Educational Activities

Rounds are every Wednesday morning at 7:30 a.m., except during summer months. No set seminars are part of the rotation, although residents are expected to attend their usual seminars at the University of Toronto weekly during their rotation.

Assessment

Trainees have daily assessments completed by staff based on CanMeds competencies. Their preceptor for the day completes the evaluation and they are compiled to complete the final evaluation.
