## Hip Replacement Surgery

## What is the process?

## Important

- Driving Restriction: Right hip-no driving for 6 weeks post-operatively; Left hip restrictions are variable
- Decrease pain
- Improve mobility
- Surgical consult: to discuss whether you will need surgery, decision to treat
- Pre-operative appointment: occurs 2-3 weeks prior to surgery, you will be given forms to be completed and bring with you to the pre-op appointment
- Surgery: Approximately 2 hours
- Hospital stay: same day/1-2 days discharged home
- Anterior Hips: Typically one day and then home
- Physiotherapy: community, 2-3 visits
- You will be able to walk with a walker and do stairs with a cane by the time you leave the hospital
- Discuss when you can return to work with your surgeon
- You may have hip precautions for up to 12 weeks
- Dental work should NOT take place 6 weeks before and 3 months after surgery
- Avoid flying for 3 months after surgery

Risks


- Infection
- Longevity
- Leg Length
- Fracture
- Post-operative confusion
- Anaesthetic
- Blood transfusion
- Blood Clots
- Dislocation
- Nerve Injury/Thigh numbness
