

## **Hip Replacement Surgery**

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How does it help?	•	Decrease pain Improve mobility	
What is the process?	•	Surgical consult: to discuss whether you will need surgery, decision to treat Pre-operative appointment: occurs 2-3 weeks prior to surgery, you will be given forms to be completed and bring with you to the pre-op appointment Surgery: Approximately 2 hours Hospital stay: same day/1-2 days discharged home Anterior Hips: Typically one day and then home Physiotherapy: community, 2-3 visits	
Important	•	You will be able to walk with a walker and do stairs with a cane by the time you leave the hospital	•
• <b>Driving Restriction:</b> Right hip—no driving for 6 weeks post-operatively; Left hip restrictions are variable	• •	Discuss when you can return to work with your surgeon You may have hip precautions for <b>up to 12 weeks</b> <b>Dental work should NOT take place 6 weeks before</b> <b>and 3 months after surgery</b> Avoid flying for 3 months after surgery
