Currently, there are 78 residents with COVID-19 at the home. There were no new cases of COVID today for residents and no new cases for staff.

Today, 44 residents have resolved COVID-19 cases and 56 staff have resolved cases. Resolved cases means that it has been 10 days since the lab test confirming COVID-19 and the individual is no longer showing COVID-19 symptoms. When staff cases are resolved they are able to return to work.

As of today, 52 residents in total have died from COVID-19 during the outbreak including three individuals who passed away from COVID-19-related causes since yesterday.

We express our deepest condolences to those who have lost a family member or friend to this devastating virus.
