

Raise Your Hand to Speak at a Video Teams Meeting

You can raise your (virtual) hand to show the meeting participants that you wish to speak during a Teams video meeting.

Note: This feature is not available in one-on-one calls.


1. Move your cursor on the screen to bring up the meeting controls bar -> Select the **Raise your hand** icon. Desktop and Laptop options may look different.

Your raised hand will be highlighted and visible to everyone. Meeting presenters will also receive a notification that your hand is raised, and they can lower your hand once you've had a chance to talk.
